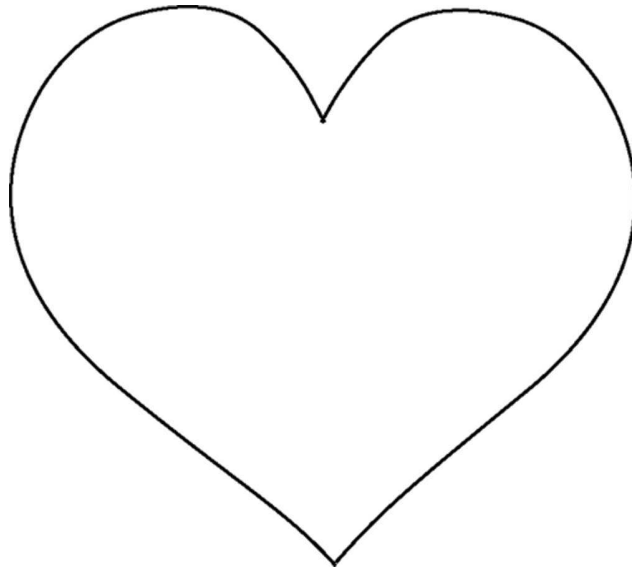


# Soup Can Fabric Sleeve



## Supplies:

- Fabric scraps
- Matching Thread
- Soup can (15 ounce)
- Interfacing (optional)

1. Cut fabric  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut appliqué shape according to above.
2. (Optional) If using thin cotton, you may want to use some iron-on interfacing.
3. Press down edges on long sides by  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", then another  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Wrap around the can to make sure that it fits properly on the top and bottom. Pin in place and sew.
4. Pin heart shape to the center of fabric and sew in place with a zig-zag stitch.
5. Turn fabric right sides together and sew remaining seam with  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance.
6. Make sure that the fabric sleeve will fit on the can (easier to slide from the bottom), then trim excess fabric and press seam open.
7. Slide sleeve onto can. Done!
