

These simple coasters are a home essential, make a quick gift, and are the perfect way to show off your smaller fabric experiments. The quilt batting in the middle gives padding for thinner fabrics. This project works especially well with painted, patchwork, or dyed fabrics.

Supplies

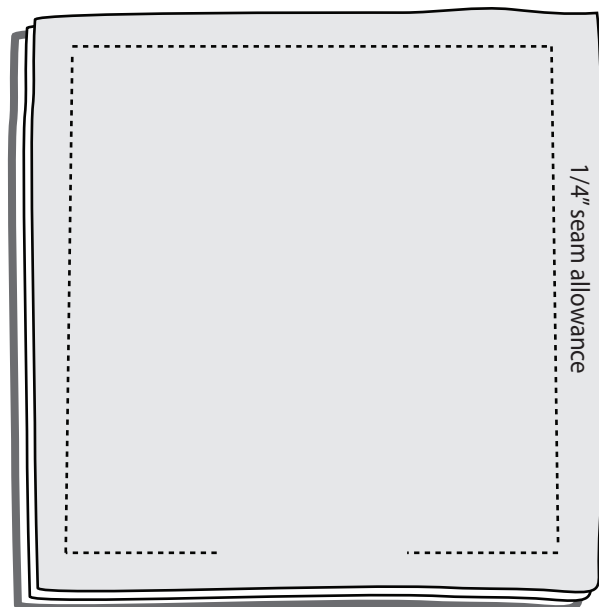
- Linen fabric and backing fabric: four pieces of each, cut into 4 1/2" squares
- Quilt batting: four pieces of each, cut into 4 1/2" squares
- Matching thread

1. Layer fabric: Layer the two pieces of fabric right sides together. Then stack the quilt batting on the bottom and pin the three layers together.

2. Sew together: Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew around the coaster, leaving an opening as shown in fig. A. Trim the corners, turn right sides out and poke out the corners. Press flat.

3. Topstitch: Stitch 1/8" from the edge to close the opening and finish the coaster. See fig. B. Repeat steps 1-3 for all coasters.
