PLANT BUCKET TUTORIAL



Supplies:

2 pieces of outer canvas fabric, 8" x 7" 2 pieces of lining canvas fabric, 8" x 7" thread, marking pencil, etc.

- 1. Cut two fabric outer pieces and two lining pieces 8" x 7" each.
- 2. Sew outer pieces right sides together, sewing around three sides with a 1/2" seam allowance, as shown in fig. A.
- 3. Sew lining pieces right sides together in the same manner, but leave a 3" opening at the bottom. See fig. B.
- 4. Next, you will square the bottom corners. Start with one corner, pulling the fabric to flatten it, aligning the seams. Press, mark, and sew 2" from the tip, as shown in fig. C.
- 5. Cut off the excess fabric and overcast or zig-zag the raw edges. See fig. D. Repeat for all four corners.
- 6. Turn the outer piece right sides out and the lining piece WRONG sides out. Place the outer piece inside the lining piece (so that right sides are facing one another), pin along the top edge and sew with a 1/2" seam allowance.
- 7. Pull the right sides out through the opening, shape into the basket, pushing out the corners. Topstitch the opening in the lining. Press the top edge of the basket all around.
